Es loosely fitting triangular drop ears are set on high and wide apart, length to the corners of the mouth

NECK

Fs strong, mid length, skin tightly fitting

F1 – looser skin under the neck

F2 – shorter

F3 – longer

CHEST

Gs broad, deep and strong”

G1 – narrow

G2 – flat

G3 – weak front chest

PROPORTIONS

Hs the length of the body 110 – 115% of height at withers

H1 shorter format

H2 longer format

BACK

Is straight and strong

I1 – slightly bent

I2 – slightly arched

LOIN

Js strong, slightly longer than rump

J1 - bent

J2 – long

J3 – short

J4 – too weak

RUMP

Ks medium long and slightly sloping

K1 – steep sloping

K2 – straight

K3 – longer

K4 – slightly overbuilt

K5 – shorter

FOREQUARTERS

Ls strong, straight and vertical, seen from the front and side.

Shoulders are very well muscled, Shoulder-blade long and well laid back.

L1 narrow from front view

L2 diverging from front view

L3 converging from front view

L4 lose elbows from front view

L5 steep from side view

L6 soft pastern from side view

L7 steep pastern from side vie

L8 - open forepaw

HINDQUARTERS:

Ms strong and vertical from back view, well angulated.

Tights are well muscled, hock joints are strong, well let down.

M1 steep from side view

M2 steep angle from side view

M3 cow hocks from back view

M4 barrel hocks from back view

M5 open hocks from back view

M6 diverging from back view

M7 wide hocks from back view

M8 narrow hocks from back view

TAIL

Ns reaching the hocks but not to the ground. According to the dog’s mood it is carried high and curved over the back or hanging down.

N1 – set high

N2 – set low

N3 – ring tail

N4 – bend over the back

N5 – longer

N6 – shorter

N7 – changes, proved by X-ray

COAT

Os long-haired coat is lightly waved and lying close, with only little undercoat. The coat is dense and close.

O1 – waved

O2 – shorter

O3 – open

O4 – straight

PIGMENTATION OF NOSE

Ps black

P1 weaker pigmentation

P2 temporary loss of pigmentation in blond dogs

MUCOSA

Qs dark pigmentation

Q1 weak pigmentation

TESTICLES AT MALES

Rs two apparently normal testicles fully descended into the scrotum.

MOVEMENT

Ss the movement of all limbs is on a straight line and good stride. The trot is extended by powerful drive from the hindquarters.

S1 – lose elbows in movement

S2 – lose back line in movement

S3 – narrow gait of the forequarters

S4 – “paddling” of the forequarters

S5 – narrow gait of the hindquarters

S6 – “bound” gait
